Rob Berry came to the St. Vrain Valley School District in the fall of 1998 as an Assistant Principal/Athletic Director at Niwot High School. He served in that position for six years. In 2004, he was offered and accepted the position of the Executive Director of Athletics, Fine Arts, PE and Health for SVVSD. He has held that position for the last 15 years.

In that capacity, Rob oversees the fine arts areas of 25 elementary schools, 12 middle schools, eight high schools and five charter schools. The SVVSD will add two more elementary schools and another middle school, opening in the fall of 2018. Rob attempts to observe over 200 music concerts throughout the school year, including eight annual high school musical productions, and oversees eight annual District Honor Music events. Along with concerts and productions, St. Vrain's music groups are also involved with local community festivals and parades. One of the local partnerships he has forged is with the Longmont Symphony Orchestra. The LSO puts on a concert for every fifth grader in the district, provides mentoring for middle and high school musicians, and promotes adopting an elementary school to inspire young budding musicians to get involved in music.

Rob also provides opportunities for St. Vrain schools to participate in music events outside the district. St. Vrain schools and programs host and/or participate in CHSAA Solo ensemble/Large groups, CBA Marching and Band competitions, Jazz festivals, College Honor groups, Western States Honor Orchestra as well as All State events for Choral, Band and Orchestra.
